Mediator Selected and Dates Set

The Union team would like to report that the Union and employer have agreed upon mediator Mr. Mort Mitchnick to assist with the next stage of negotiations.

Mediation dates have been set for November 14, 2018 through to November 16, 2018 in Yellowknife. These dates were the first available dates where all three parties were available and could attend.

Mr. Mitchnick is a lawyer based in the Toronto area who currently has a private arbitration practice. He has extensive experience as an arbitrator and a mediator. He previously was a law partner with the firm of Miller Thomson in Toronto and was a former Vice Chair and former Chair of the Ontario Labour Relations Board.

He has also served for a number of years on the standing panel of arbitrators in various industries, including Major League Baseball, power generation, the steel and airline industries, and the community college, university and municipal sectors.

Mr. Mitchnick's publications among others include: Labour Arbitration in Canada and Leading Cases in Labour Arbitration.

The team will continue to work on behalf of the membership to achieve a fair deal with the employer as mediation progresses.

We take this opportunity to again thank you for your continued support and patience during this lengthy process and ask that you stay tuned for future communications on bargaining.
