UNW and Dominion Reach Tentative Agreement

We are happy to announce that the UNW/PSAC has reached tentative agreement with Dominion Diamonds which will **save 150 union jobs** from being contracted out and address the Employer's concerns about absenteeism.

The UNW and Dominion met for almost a week for intense discussions about how to come to this agreement. If ratified, this agreement will result in keeping 150 jobs in the unionized work force, provide protections and job security for the entire bargaining unit, and will make changes to the leave programs that will benefit both the members and the Employer. The agreement will also extend the life of the collective agreement to May 31, 2022, which will provide stability for members.

Meetings are being planned for the mine site, where members can get information and vote on ratification. Stay tuned for dates and further information very soon!

Ratification packages will be available at the UNW Local office at the mine site, and will be emailed to all members whose email addresses we have on file.
