To: UNW members who are NTPC Employees

An agreement remains in place between the parties not to comment publicly on the specifics of negotiations. However, given the time that has elapsed between bargaining sessions, we thought it important to recap where we are in the bargaining process.

As most of you are aware, your bargaining team met with the Employer quite some time ago in January of this year. Despite our best efforts to reach a reasonable compromise and get to a fair settlement, we were unable to do so. At this time, our financial proposals remain the same as presented in January of this year.

We had meeting dates planned for this past June, which unfortunately, had to be rescheduled.

We are still working with the Employer to find dates for the next session of negotiations and hope to be able to communicate those dates to you as soon as possible, once they have been confirmed.

There will be a verbal update at the Local Presidents' meeting in July, and bargaining update general membership meetings are being scheduled in a number of communities over the next few months.

Your bargaining team will continue to advocate on your behalf and will fight for fair wage increases for NTPC employees that keep up with inflation.
