Listen for our bargaining messages!

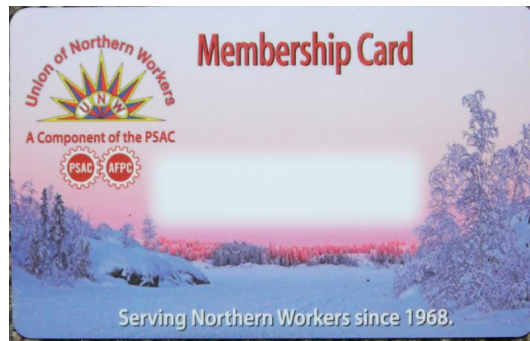
We have started playing UNW advertisements related to bargaining with the GNWT.
